



European Electronique has created a new and inspiring learning environment for The Darwen Aldridge Community Academy (DACA). The building is designed to provide students with an enhanced learning experience which incorporates a development of entrepreneurial skills.

The project included an installation of a Meru virtualised wireless system, which provides students, administrators and educators with a seamless network access via thousands of connected devices such

as wireless netbooks, laptops and PCs to support mobile learning initiatives.

European Electronique also provided a bespoke SharePoint learning platform, seamlessly integrating a Moodle VLE and other key systems into a centralised point of access. A custom branding was applied inline with the academy's existing collateral that created an entirely bespoke auto provisioning eco-system between the Academy MIS system, Active Directory, Moodle and Sharepoint.
